## Call for Papers! Information

Theme: **LEADERSHIP IN A TIME OF CHANGE**  
**CLOSING DATE: MAY 1, 2023**

Manuscript consideration for AAPEL (AJEL) Volume X, 2023, will be accepted from October 1 until May 1. The anticipated journal publication date is September 2023. To submit materials for consideration, send one electronic copy of the manuscript and requested information using MS Word to the journal editor.

- ✓ Full research papers with results are preferred, but theoretical contributions, action research, and literature reviews are considered on a limited basis per volume.
- ✓ On the first file, list the following: article title, each author's name, professional title, highest degree obtained, institutional affiliation, email address, telephone and FAX numbers, and a note saying you are the author(s) authorizing permission to publish must accompany the manuscript.
- ✓ On the second file, include the title, a 100-200 word abstract, and five keywords.
- ✓ The third file should be the manuscript with no identifiable information to facilitate a triple-blind review of the manuscript.
- ✓ All files should be in MS Word.
- ✓ The manuscript **must**:
  - Adhere to the criteria and standards of the APA Manual (7th Edition) (<http://www.apastyle.org>).
  - 2,000 to 3,000 words in length (approximately 15-20 pages, not including references).
  - Single-spaced, upper and lower case, 12-point Times New Roman font with one-inch margins on all sides, each page numbered.
  - For figures and tables, use 10-12 font sizes in Times Roman, Garamond, or Arial.
  - As applicable, indicate all research funding sources in the manuscript's acknowledgment section.
  - As applicable: If using race/ethnicity, define and include why race/ethnicity is considered important in the study.
  - As applicable, obtain and acknowledge permission from the copyright owner to use/reproduce copyrighted content (e.g., figures and tables) in the submitted manuscript.
  - As applicable, provide written permission from any potentially identifiable individuals referred to or shown in photographs in the manuscript.
